ADMISSION GUIDELINES AND SCHEDULE OF VARIOUS COURSES FOR THE ACADEMIC SESSION 2020-2021

APPLYING FOR NCPE ADMISSION PROCEDURE

Applicants seeking admission in NCPE should note that he/she should follow the steps given herein. The admission procedure is also pasted on the College notice board for reference.

Step 1 : Collect the prescribed application form of the college which is attached with the Prospectus.

Step 2 : Submit the duly filled application form with necessary documents:

- General Information Form
- Identity Card Form
- Undertaking by the candidate (for Anti Ragging)
- Enrolment Confirmation Form

Applicants seeking admission shall submit the self-attested photocopies (3 copies) of the following documents:

- Self-attested copy of **Class X Board Certificate** (for the date of birth)
- Self-attested copy of **Class XII Marks-Sheet**, if result is announced. (In case Mark-Sheet is not issued by the Board then the self-attested copy of the Mark-Sheet downloaded from the respective boards' website should be attested).
- Copy of **Class XII Provisional Certificate**.
- Copy of **Character certificate** from the school/ college last attended.
- Copy of **Transfer Certificate** from school/ college as well as **Migration Certificate** from Board/University is required for those students who have passed senior secondary exam from C.B.S.E. Board.
- Self-attested copy of **Caste Certificate**, along with the Income Certificate either of mother / father / brother / sister.
- Self-attested copy of **income certificate** (for OBC non-creamy layer) Certificate, if applicable.
- Self-attested copy of **Sport Certificate(s)** for last three years (National or International), if applicable.
- Self-attested copy of **Extra Curricular Activities Certificate(s)**, if applicable.
- Proof of permanent residence of the student and parent viz. electricity bill, **AADHAR card, Voter ID, Election card, receipt of property tax payment. MTNL/BSNL telephone bill.**
- **Copy of AADHAR card is mandatory (Both self and parents).**
- Five recent passport size **photographs**.
- Prescribed undertaking duly signed by the parent/guardian as regards genuineness of the documents submitted for admission.
- Students belong to BPL Category (Below Poverty Line) have to submit an income certificate/affidavit for purpose of student aid fund at the time of admission.

Note:

1. For any query related to the fees or mode of payment, contact the Admission Cell Incharge.
2. It is mandatory for every student applying for the admission, to meet the Admission Cell Incharge or else the admission form will not be accepted.
3. Original Admission form attached with the prospectus has to be submitted in person. Photocopy of the form will be rejected instantly.
4. ID-Card form is mandatory to be submitted along with the admission form, or else the form will not be accepted.
5. Fee has to be submitted during the time of admission or else the name of the student will not be added in the attendance register.
6. 1st installment before the time of admission and 2nd installment before 30th November.
7. Sports Kit will be available at the store counter (Physical Education Students).

POST-ADMISSION

Important Information

- Once a candidate is selected and takes admission after completing all the procedures, his/her enrolment is approved by the University;
- Any student submitting false/forged/fake certificates will be debarred from admission to any course, and would be liable to legal action. Admission can also be cancelled and no fee refund will be made in any circumstances. Such cases will be notified to all colleges and to the police. Candidates are instructed to read the guidelines given below carefully before submission of the application form.

Orientation Day for New Entrants

The College welcomes its new student members by organizing an Orientation Programme. Students are familiarized with the college environment, acquainted with the rules and regulations of the college and also informed about the facilities available and other extracurricular activities held in the college. This helps them in making their stay in college comfortable and fruitful. The Orientation Day will be informed through College website. All the new students are advised to carry their admissions slip with them.

Identity Card

Every student is given an Identity Card, which he/she must bring to the College every day. This card must be produced as and when required. Disciplinary action may be taken on failure to do so. If the Identity card is lost, a duplicate must be obtained on payment of Rs. 200/-.

Notice Boards/Website

Students should make it a habit to read the notice board/website regularly to check notices for schedule of classes, examinations, holidays, activities and other information of relevance. Ignorance of any notice will not be accepted as a plea or an excuse for any delay in any matter.



ADMISSION GUIDELINES

- Once a decision on a candidate's application for admission is taken, the college will not entertain any personal representation, correspondence or telephonic inquiries on the subject.
- Admissions are made on merit basis and admission to a course is closed as soon as the seats are filled. Information in this regard will be notified on the College Notice Board.
- A candidate can take admission only in one course in one college at any given time. In case a student wishes to withdraw/cancel the admission in a course/college, the candidate should approach the college where the admission is taken. Only after the college cancels the admission of a candidate, the candidate can proceed to take admission in other courses/colleges.
- Submitting the application does not guarantee the admission in the college.
- The college DOES NOT COLLECT DONATIONS in any form for admission. The college has not appointed any outside agency or individuals to select students for admission. If anyone approaches you promising admission on payment of money please bring it to the notice of the Principal.
- Forms incomplete in any respect will be rejected.
- Applicants who fail to deposit the prescribed fee within the period in the admission notice shall not be granted admission.
- Candidates desirous of taking admission in the college hostel should clearly indicate in admission form of college. Once college admission is complete, student should approach hostel for registration along with fee receipt of college. After getting their fee receipt they should register themselves in the hostel.
- If any student does not report within 15 days of the commencement of the classes or stay absent from classes without any prior permission or relevant reason his/her name will be automatically struck off from the college.
- If any student achieve the compulsory attendance and fills the examination form but due to some unavoidable circumstances unable to appear in the University examination he will be considered as an ex- student. He has to re-appear in future examination as an ex-student.

Strict action will be taken against such students who will be found involved in any following mischievous activities:

- Causing damage to College Building, Furniture or found misbehaving with any college official/employees.



- Students are advised to keep their mobiles on silent mode in college campus, if found using mobiles strict action will be taken against such students.
- Any act of indiscipline, smoking, consuming any alcoholic material is prohibited in the college campus.
- Any type of Ragging is totally prohibited in the college. If any student found involved in such act, strict disciplinary action will be taken as per the rules and regulations of the U.G.C. and University.

ADMISSION CANCELLATION/WITHDRAWAL

Any student interested in getting his/her admission cancelled is required to fill a Performa available from the College Office and submit it to the Coordinator Admission Committee. After this date, a student may withdraw from the College by making an application to Principal intimating of withdrawal. Otherwise they will be liable to pay the fee of the period for which their name remains on the rolls.

1. For the cancellation of admission, a candidate has to apply in the prescribed form duly signed by him/her and counter signed by his/her parent/guardian at respective college.
2. The candidate has to enclose the original fee receipt & photocopy of "No-Due" (Original submit at respective college) along with the form.
3. Refund will be made only after the candidate has surrendered the ID card, original fee receipt and the dues clearance certificate.
4. Application and Examination fees, wherever applicable, once remitted shall not be refunded under any circumstances.

REFUND OF FEE

If the student chooses to withdraw from the program of studies in which he/she is enrolled, the refund of the fees will be made as per the details given below:

1. 100 % fees will be refunded before the formal announcement/notice about the last date of admission.
2. 80 % of the fees will be refunded, no more than 15 days after the formal announcement/notice about the last date of admission.
3. 50 % of the fees will be refunded after 15 days but less than 30 days after the formal announcement/notice about the last date of admission.
4. No refund will be done after 30 days of the formal announcement/notice about the last date of admission.

Note : Fee shall be refunded as per rules by the institute to an eligible candidate only after receiving a written application from him/her in this regard.



INSTRUCTIONS FOR STUDENTS

Removal from the College

The Principal is empowered to remove the name of a student from the college rolls if, in the opinion of the Principal, he/she

- is grossly irregular in attendance or
- is not amenable to the college discipline or
- is guilty of gross negligence in studies or
- is not found fit for the course chosen by him/ her or (v) has not paid College dues in time.

Re-Admission

A student, whose name is removed from the college rolls for non-payment of fees or for another reason, may be permitted re-admission at the discretion of the Principal on written request by the student.

Such re-admission shall be on payment of re-admission fees, arrears of tuition fees and fines, after the permissions granted.

Library Card

Students need to furnish their fee receipt and the college Identity Card to become a member of the library. The library card is non-transferable.

Attendance

The attendance is compulsory for all the students. The student will not be allowed to appear in the examination if his/her attendance is below 75% percentage. Students are advised to attend the classes regularly.

- Attendance will be counted from the date of commencement of teaching.
- It is the responsibility of the student to collect information about his/her attendance from the concerned teachers within first week of the month.

Visitors

Students are not permitted to receive or entertain visitors in the college. In case of extreme urgency they must seek prior permission from the Principal / Administrative Officer.

Residential Address

In case of change in residential address, the same must be intimated in writing under the signature of parents/guardians to the college Office without delay.



INFRASTRUCTURE

Campus

NCPE is known for its aesthetic elegance of its buildings, spacious lawns, ubiquitous sports grounds and lush green environment which is spread over 22 acres of serene green land. The existing infrastructural facilities are utilized both for conducting theory and practical classes.

Innovative techniques and modern technology continue to provide the students with an effective learning environment. To this end the institute provides varied infrastructure for indoor and outdoor games, fully equipped Gymnasium, Conference Hall, Computer Lab, Seminar Hall, Shooting Range, Language Lab, Yoga/Meditation Room, Music Room, Cultural Lab, Psychology Lab, Biology Lab, and Sociology Lab.

The campus boasts of in-house facilities like state of the art labs, spacious classrooms; air cooled, separate hostels for boys and girls, mess with hygienic food and a college cafeteria, health care center, gym, tennis etc. to cater to all the necessities of the hostel students and the staff.

CLASS ROOMS

The classrooms are spacious and well-ventilated with proper seating arrangements for the students to be comfortably accommodated for conducting theory classes.



CONFERENCE/SEMINAR HALL

College has two seminar halls to conduct conferences, seminars and workshops for students and faculty members with Big seminar hall having the capacity of 150 seating capacity and the small one has 100 seating capacity. Seminar halls are completely air conditioned and are equipped with LCD Projectors, white boards, public addressing system with internet connectivity.



THE LIBRARY - KNOWLEDGE RESOURCE CENTRE

The College has central library and four departmental libraries which is equipped with the latest and rare collection of literature in the field of Physical Education & Sports, Education and Technical Education with 35,000 text books.

The library has taken initiative to enrich with good numbers of textbooks, reference books, books beyond the text, journals, magazine and E-resources like e-books, e-journals, e-articles related to subject and curriculum of the college which provides support to teachers and students. OPAC (Online Public Access Catalogue) facility is in process.



FACULTY

Faculty at NCPE with their Academic and Practical expertise aims to groom the students into complete professionals. We have a pool of dedicated faculty members who work hard to make the student suitable for higher learning & professional competence. The faculty leaves no stone unturned in the development of students by way of classroom teaching, group discussion, Seminar, Presentation, co-curricular activities, viz. Scout Guide camp, Intramural Tournament, Community work, Excursions. Faculty members have International exposure of sports.





LABORATORIES

All our laboratories are well equipped and well maintained not only for carrying out curriculum oriented lab practical's but also to carry out research activities. All the laboratories are established as per NCTE and University norms with over 10 Laboratories pertaining Physical Education, Education, Management and Computer Science with all the latest equipment machinery and instruments in place.



PLAY FIELDS AND FACILITIES

The college has ample play facilities for the entire gamut of physical activities. Well maintained indoor and outdoor area for athletics, gymnastics, football, handball, volleyball, kabaddi, khokho, badminton, table-tennis, wrestling, judo, basketball, cricket, lawn-tennis, yoga etc. Apart from these facilities, the college has fully equipped gymnasium with latest equipment's for promotion of fitness





MUSIC ROOM

The Music Room is equipped with a variety of instruments to facilitate the students in their practical work and hence equip them with skills of better co-ordination with different instruments. The students learn Hindustani vocal music and get a chance to perform at various college and inter-college functions.



ANNUAL CULTURAL AND TECHNICAL FEST

Cultural activities and education have an intimate relationship. Without the cultural programs, education is incomplete. It plays a vital role in the social development. Keeping this in mind our cultural club-Jhankar organizes numerous series of events like Rangoli, Bulletin, Boards, Dance, etc. across the year to ensure the wholesome development of the students.

The students are actively involved in various technical events viz. paper presentation, Collage making, Poster and present making, Poetry recitation, Essay competition and other events.

INTER DEPARTMENT SPORTS COMPETITIONS - THE INTRAMURAL

Intramural are organized to give hands on experience to the students in organizing the games and sports. The entire college is divided into four Houses. Each house has a teacher in-charge, a Captain and a Vice-Captain to handle various teams of the houses. This houses system inculcates the qualities of leadership, co-operation, mutual understanding, tolerance and self-reliance. 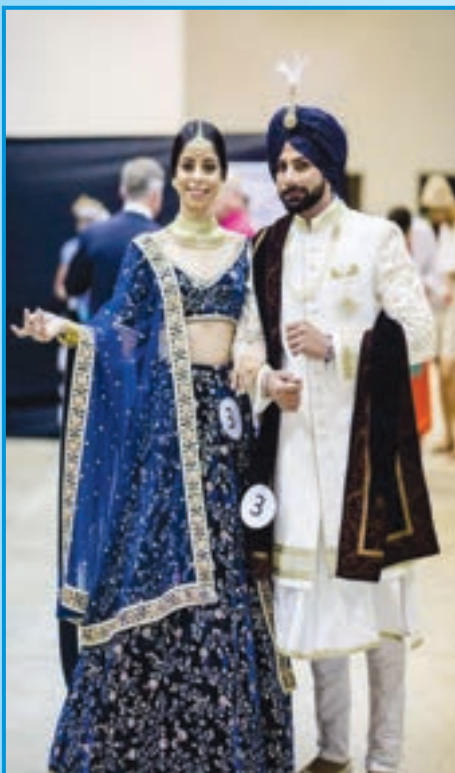

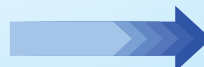

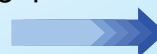

1. **Non-Liability** : Prospectus Application form and all other Admission Correspondence will be self submitted or sent by Post/Courier. NCPE is not responsible for Postal/Courier delays or loss in transit.
2. **Non-refund of fees** : All fees once paid are not refundable for any reason whatsoever.
3. **Cancellation of Admission** : NCPE reserves its right to cancel the admission of successful candidate under any of the following circumstance:
 - a) If the fees is not deposited by the stipulated date.
 - b) If the candidate does not join the particular programme by the stipulated date even though the fee has been deposited.
 - c) If the candidate fails to furnish the proof of the stipulated minimum qualifications.
 - d) If any instance of donation/unfair means is found after admission.
 - e) If any of the document(s) submitted by you to NCPE is found to be forged, fabricated or false during the period of your study, your admission shall be cancelled immediately and fees shall be forfeited. In case you complete the course and obtain the degree on the basis of documents which are later found to be forged, fabricated or false, at any point of time, your degree shall be cancelled/recalled.
4. **Right of Alteration/Modification:**
 - (a) NCPE reserves its right to alter or modify the structure of any of the programs to attain the objective of excellence.

RAGGING FREE CAMPUS

Ragging is an offence in any form and is totally prohibited inside the premises of NOIDA COLLEGE OF PHYSICAL EDUCATION. The rule applies to the hostels and college transportation too. FORMS OF RAGGING :

Display of noisy, disorderly conduct, teasing, excitement by rough or rude treatment or handling, including rowdy, undisciplined activities which cause or likely to cause annoyance, undue hardship, physical or psychological harm or raise apprehensive fear in a fresher, or asking the students to do any act or perform something which such a student will not do in the ordinary course and which causes him/her shame or embarrassment or danger to his/her life, etc.

PUNISHMENT FOR PARTICIPATION IN/OR ABETMENT OF RAGGING :

- Cancellation of admission.
- Suspension from attending classes.
- Withholding/withdrawing scholarship/fellowship and other benefits.
- Debarring from appearing in any test/examination or other evaluation process.
- Withholding results.
- Debarring from representing the institution in any national or international meet, tournament, youth festival, etc.
- Suspension/expulsion from the hostel.
- Rustication from the institution for periods varying from 1 to 4 semesters or equivalent period.
- Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution.
- Collective punishment: when the person committing or abetting the crime of ragging are not identifies, the institution shall resort to collective punishment as a deterrent to community pressure on the potential raggars.
